At work, volunteering or at play, she never hesitated to get involved, quietly leading the way. She was a true friend, a hard worker and a tireless volunteer. Deanna will be remembered for her love of sport and active living. Growing up in rural Alberta, you could find her on the ball diamond in the summer and

at the curling rink or skating in the winter. She cherished her time outdoors; skiing, hiking, camping and gardening. She looked forward to vacations, exotic or simple. And, she never turned down an offer to go dancing. Life was not always easy but when she got knocked down, she never failed to pick herself up, dust herself off and proudly walk on. Deanna’s vibrant, energetic life was cut short by ALS. In spite of the many challenges living with this disease, Deanna continued to be our teacher by demonstrating to us her resilience, adaptability and the gracious acceptance of her limitations. Through her example, we learned to embrace the person she was becoming rather than mourn the person we were losing. Her illness further united our family. We will treasure the gift of family time spent traveling to places afar and the recent road-trip back in time, gatherings with extended family, dancing at any opportunity, discovering watercolour painting when she could no longer grip a pencil, endless games of cards, quiet drives into the countryside and making many new friends on our journey through her illness. Deanna will be forever loved and remembered by her six daughters, Brenda Sawers (Glen Springsteel), Cathy Ens (Dale), Charlene Sawers (Kris Basford), Billie-Lou Laskosky (Ken McClennon), Lynn Johnson (Kevin), and Laurie Allan (Scott).
