Friends and family will remember Warren's love of life that included spending time with family, baseball of all sorts, a round of golf, a curling game, a canoe ride, musical experiences from Dixieland Jazz to Barbershop Quartet singing. He loved his time with the Blackie Gladys Players and felt rewarded by his career as a draftsman. Travelling with Shirley was very special for Warren and his role as a Minister's spouse brought him great satisfaction.

Warren's creativity was evident in much of his woodwork and many Southern Alberta families have a special rocking horse that provides hours of enjoyment to little ones.

Warren talked often about "being blessed" and all who met him felt this.
