

Mr. A. Cameron Forsythe

January 4, 1948 - February 9, 2023

Mr. Cameron Forsythe of High River, Alberta passed away suddenly on February 9, 2023 at the age of 75 years. Cam is survived by his son Grant Forsythe (Sue), daughter Pamela Gauthier (Rob), sisters Sandra Higgins (James), Marlis Pollock (Garry), and brother Bob Forsythe (Corrine), as well and several nieces and nephews.

He is predeceased by his father Arthur Gordon Forsythe and mother Phyllis Forsythe, Son Daniel Forsythe, Sister Terri Forsythe, and Brothers-in-Law Gordon Brace and Don Bird.

Cam was born in Swift Current, Saskatchewan on January 4th, 1948. He was the second of five children. The family eventually moved to Maple Creek, Saskatchewan where he would grow up and start a family. He met Peggy Hannah and were married December 6th, 1968. They had three children, Grant, Daniel, and Pam. Daniel passed away at age 6 months in 1969. Cam and Peggy were divorced in 1973.

Cam worked several jobs before finding his passion behind the wheel as a truck driver. He worked for companies mostly out of Saskatchewan until getting a job with Mullen Trucking in High River where he would move and settle. He drove for Mullen for many years before starting his business, Cam's Flag Car Service. He delivered trailers for Factory Outlet Trailers for

the last few years before his death.

A Memorial Jam honoring Cam's life will be held at the Heritage Inn in High River on April 15th, at 2:00 pm.
