



Mr. Albert Pearson Gow

December 11, 1938 - March 29, 2023

It is with heavy hearts that we share the peaceful passing of Albert Pearson Gow at the High River Hospital in Alberta on March 29, 2023 at the age of 84 years.

Remembered fondly by his wife, Phyllis, their son Gordon and his wife Catherine, and grandson Davis as well as son Marvin (Ted), his wife Becki and son Stephen and his partner, Katie Saich, Albert was also a great brother, uncle and friend to many.

Albert (also known as Ab) was born in Kingston on December 11, 1938, the eighth in a family of 16 Gow siblings, of which there are still five surviving brothers (Bill, Glenn, Paul, Michael, Rick) and one sister (Judy), not to mention many in-laws, nieces and nephews.

Growing up in Kingston as well as Port Colborne, Albert would eventually meet and marry Phyllis Clancy, and the couple would soon raise a family first in both the Kingston and the Toronto area before moving to Calgary, Alberta in the mid-1970s.

Albert worked in various roles for DuPont Canada, a career that would see him earn a stellar reputation in sales, management and as a leader in several divisions of the company until his retirement after more than 35 years of

service.

Albert and Phyllis would spend several years enjoying retirement at their trailer in Radium Hot Springs, B.C. where they were surrounded by the peace of a running creek, golfing and relaxing by the firepit, with Ab - ever the master of the fire "poker".

Ab and Phyllis also travelled extensively in their retirement, enjoying several cruises and touring such far-flung countries as China, Australia, New Zealand, and throughout several regions of Europe and the U.S.

More recently, Ab and Phyllis would relocate to High River to enjoy their twilight years where they found solace in the quiet rural setting, and enjoyed golfing, a return to bowling and entertaining family.

There has been no service planned for Albert, however a memorial will be arranged in the future.

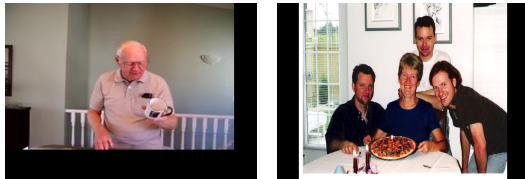
