It is with deep sadness we announce the sudden and tragic passing of Austin Stuart on May 3, 2014 at the young age of 20 years old.

Austin spent the early years of his life growing up in Turner Valley, AB until moving to Osoyoos, BC in 2004 and graduating from Osoyoos High School in 2011. Ozzy loved the great outdoors; quadding, biking, boating and rollerblading. He was very mechanically inclined and from a young age liked to take things apart to see what made them work. Austin loved to hang out with "Uncle", his partner in crime, building and inventing contraptions like super toboggans to fixing and modifying cars, quads and motorbikes.
