whom a constant bantering back and forth with loving insults was the norm and most definitely our trips to his favourite weekend spot at the cottage with Judi and Ray while in Nova Scotia...a place he loved dearly. The family reunion during Stampede also created many lasting memories along with teasing and inside jokes for years to follow.

Brent was forever grateful for the tremendous care and outpouring of support that he received from Tonya who made sure to always be there for him. He was eternally grateful that she sacrificed so much to make sure that he was comfortable and surrounded by love in his final stages.
