Mr. Bruce Petersen of Calgary, Alberta passed away at the Peter Lougheed Centre on April 15, 2024 at the age of 76 years. Bruce is survived by his daughter Tanya (Albert); son Rob and treasured daughter-in-law Sherry; grandchildren Spencer, Kira, Kylie, and Karsyn; and new great-grandson Kassius. As well as his brother Hubert (Susan) Petersen, sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Eleanor and Terry Killough, sister-in-law Glenda Spencer, many nieces, nephews, and extended family and friends.
