Captain Reid Leslie Habing, CD of Cayley, Alberta passed away on February 11th, 2019 at the age of 42 years. In October of 1996 they started dating and later married on September 18, 1999. This was the beginning of a beautiful life and family, of which Reid was unabashedly proud to call his own. Reid had a personality that was bigger than life. He devoted his time to his family and poured all of his spare time into his beloved cadets at the 187 Foothills Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron and was proud to see his sons follow in his footsteps.

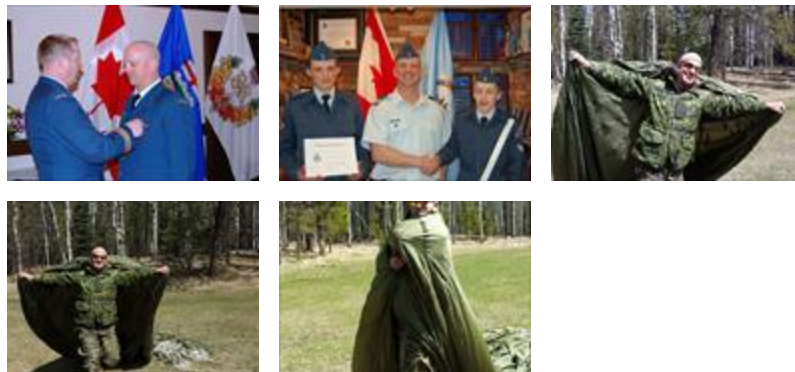

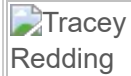
