Mr. Christopher Chin-Fatt of High River, Alberta passed away on August 28, 2022 at home at the age of 70 years. Chris is survived by his wife Donna; daughter Robyn (Blair); son Adam; grandchildren Lincoln, Eldon and Rory; and siblings Avril, Kurth, Beverley, Janet and Dave.

Chris was born in Kingston, Jamaica to Alfred and Eva Chin-Fatt. He attended Blake's Preparatory School and St. George's College in Kingston and completed his B.E. in Chemical Engineering at Vanderbilt University in Tennessee. He married Donna, the love of his life, in 1977. Over 35 years, he was a key player in the growth of the petroleum industry in Jamaica through his work with Petrojam Limited (previously Esso West Indies). In 2005, Chris and Donna moved to Alberta, eventually choosing to settle in High River for its wide, open spaces and quieter life.

Chris' favourite place to be was on the ocean, and he was happy sailing, snorkelling, scuba diving and spearfishing. He also always loved hiking and rock collecting, so after moving to Canada, he found joy in hiking in the Rocky Mountains, and even learnt to ski in his late 50's. His greatest joy in his later years was the antics of his young grandchildren.

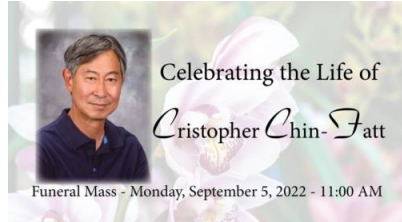

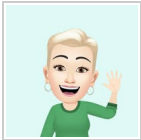
