Mr. Clayton Moncrieff of Cayley, Alberta passed away at the High River Hospital, surrounded by his family, on August 10, 2022 at the age of 83 years. Clayton is survived by his children Delbert (Linda), Mary, Loretta (Lyle) and Lorne; 8 grandchildren; 4 great-grandchildren; his brother Lloyd (Millie) Moncrieff as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
