Cory Allen Goodman of High River, Alberta passed away in the presence of family and dear friends at the High River Hospital at the age of 56 years.

“Big C” will be fondly remembered for his warmth, humour, and the deep kindness

he shared with all who knew him.

Cory is survived by his loving wife Sheri, and their children who share many of his incredible qualities — daughter Sarah and son Adam.

But it was home where he was in his glory as a loving husband, a supportive father, an incredible cook, a gracious host, and the biggest pushover of a dog dad you've ever met.

Cory's life was marked by a profound love for his family and community. He was an unwavering friend, always ready with a helping hand, a story to share, or a laugh to lift your spirits. His dedication, generosity, and compassion touched many lives and will be cherished in memory.

Following Cory's glioblastoma diagnosis, he received remarkable support from dozens of family and friends who filled the Goodman home with love. The family wishes to express their heartfelt gratitude to everyone who supported them in keeping Cory at home, and to those who were always checking in or lending a helping hand.
