May 23, 1951 - March 1, 2024

Mr. Craig Kimler of High River, Alberta passed away peacefully with family by his side at the High River Hospital on March 1, 2024 at the age of 72 years.

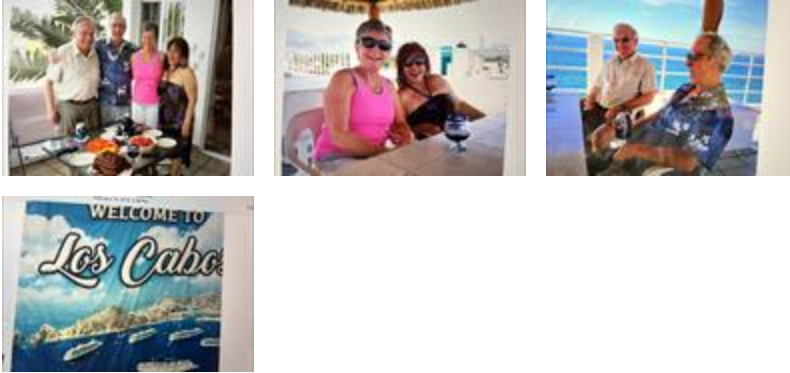
