



Mrs. Dolores Brown

March 6, 1933 - April 23, 2013

Mrs. Dolores M. Brown passed away peacefully surrounded by her family on April 23, 2013 at the High River Hospital at the age of 80 years following a long battle with cancer. Dolores is survived by her children Greg (Dianne) of Swift Current, Sask., Jim of Longview, AB., Brian (Freda) of Tanzania, Africa, Brett (Kelly) of High River, AB., Sherry (Don) of Calgary, AB., Colleen (Don) of Longview, AB., Wayne (Val) of Calgary, AB., Don (Sandy) of Lloydminster, AB.; siblings Peggy (Albert) of Stettler, AB., Loretta (Paul) of Lethbridge, AB., Linda (Rick) of Red Deer, AB. as well as numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews. Dolores was predeceased by her husband Sydney James Richard Brown in 1986; parents Cecil and Maggie Darby; brothers Dick and Donald and sister Lucille.

Dolores was born on the farm near Redvers, Saskatchewan and graduated high school from Wilcox, Saskatchewan. Dolores married Sydney in 1958 and they moved to Calgary where they raised their children before moving to High River in 1979. Dolores worked at the High River Hospital for many years before moving back to Wilcox, Saskatchewan to work in the archives at Notre Dame while her grandson was attending school. She moved back to High River in 2004 where she remained until her passing. Dolores' life was dedicated to her family and her friends, especially her babies.
