



## Mrs. Donna Lorraine Fox

October 21, 1943 - January 19, 2025

Mrs. Donna Fox of Okotoks, Alberta passed away surrounded by her family at the High River Hospital on January 19, 2025 at the age of 81 years.

Donna was born in High River, Alberta on October 21, 1943 and grew up in the Foothills area and Calgary. She married Robert on December 15, 1962 in Calgary, Alberta where they lived with their children Liane and Raymond (Ray) until they moved to Okotoks in 1978.

Donna is survived by her children, Liane (Danny) and Raymond (Cheryl); grandchildren Tyne (Stephen), Layne (Karalee) and Braden (Alexa) and greatgrandchildren Georgina and Gideon; Sydney and Adelaide; Braxton, Carter and Ethan. Donna was predeceased by Robert who passed away in January of 1999.

Over the years, Donna was a very active volunteer with her church and community organizations. She volunteered with the Canadian Cancer Society in Calgary. In Okotoks she volunteered with Block Parents and with the CNIB. After Robert had a stroke in 1985, she became acquainted with the William Watson Lodge in Kananaskis. She eventually became a board member with the Society stepping down after 25 years in 2024.

Donna was a very active member of Windmill Theatre Players in High River

after Robert and Ray became involved with the group in 1982. Never wanting to be on stage, she worked back stage and in the front of house doing everything from props to being producer and working with dinner theatre.
