Dorothy Robinson passed away on Tuesday, September 5th, 2023, at the age of 92. She is survived by two of her children, Sandra and Robert; 6 grandchildren, Jennifer, Rebecca (Mauricio), Kyle, Max (Nicole), Dyllan, and Chase; 6 great grandchildren, Baylie, Morgan, Keyra, Isabel, Senna, and Arianna; and four nieces and nephews. Dorothy was predeceased by her husband Bob, her daughter Dianne, and her brother Barry.

Dorothy was born in Toronto, Canada on November 10th, 1930, to her loving parents Charlotte and Harold Odell; the second child following her brother Barry.
