Ferne Knight of High River, Alberta went home to be with Jesus on January 11, 2023 at the High River Hospital at the age of 86 years. Ferne is survived by her three daughters, Ginny Olson (Stuart), Pam Ganske (Bruce), and Angie Knight; grandchildren, Camille Hare (Jesse), Neal Ganske (Natalie), and Anton Olson; seven great grandchildren, Asher, Finn, Selah and Wyatt Ganske, and Oakland, Tru and Livvie Hare; her twin sister, Myrna Jensen (Paul); and several nieces and nephews. Ferne was predeceased by her husband, David H. Knight in June of 2018.

Ferne was born in Innisfail, Alberta. She grew up in a musical family in the Danish farming community near Dickson, Alberta. She attended high school in Three Hills, Alberta. After high school, Ferne and her twin, Myrna, moved to Calgary to work. During that time, she met David, her “Knight” in shining armour. She finished her nurse’s training in 1956. In 1957, Ferne and David were married. They resided in Edmonton, where their daughters were born. They moved to Calgary in 1967 where she was a nurse, working primarily in the newborn nursery at the Calgary General Hospital. In 2001 Ferne and David moved to High River.

Throughout her life, Ferne faithfully served by playing piano for church services, leading choirs of all age groups, teaching Sunday School and leading Young Life Club. She also led Ladies Bible studies, and she participated in overseas missions to Africa and Asia.

She loved to garden and was active in walking clubs and enjoyed being outdoors, bicycling with various family members.
