



## Mr. George Murray Webb

June 9, 1932 - October 18, 2024

Mr. George Murray Webb of High River, Alberta passed away at the High River Hospital on October 18th at the age of 92 years.

George is survived by his daughter Deb Bombenon of Foothills, AB, his son Duane Webb (Deneen Stoby) of Edmonton, AB and his daughter Deanna Weder (Mike) of Okotoks, AB and his grandchildren Tyler, Dana, Natalie and Wyatt and his great grandson Jackson. He is also survived by his sister, Patricia Ann Holland of Halifax, NS.

He was predeceased by his father, George D. Webb, mother, Marie Hopewell and stepmother, Jean Fitzpatrick Webb as well as his brother James Lawrence Webb.

George was born in Halifax, NS and was educated at St. Mary's University in Electrical Engineering. He moved to Toronto to start his career in sales of electrical equipment, where he met his wife, Barbara Grieve and started a family, living in Bay Ridges and Mississauga. He was involved in the community as part of the Kinsmen Club in Streetsville, and an active volunteer in Erindale minor hockey. Their family moved to Okotoks, AB in 1981 to continue his career working in Calgary. George loved spending time with family, gardening, playing cards and socializing with friends. He especially loved music and dancing. In retirement, he enjoyed travel with his lady friend

Liz Kehler including trips to Europe, Peru and to Toronto to watch the Blue Jays.

The family would like to thank the staff at High River Hospital long-term care. He struggled with Age-related Macular Degeneration (AMD) and was confined to a wheelchair after a hip injury, but the staff kept him busy with music programs and gardening. He always knew the songs and was often singing or dancing in his chair in the front row.

A private family celebration will be held, and he has requested his ashes be spread in Halifax at his family plot.
