January 21, 1934 - August 5, 2017

Gerald (Jerry) Grant of High River, Alberta passed away peacefully at the High River Hospital on August 5, 2017 at the age of 83 years. He is survived by his sons Bruce (Bonnie) Grant and Michael (Karen) Grant; grandchildren Stacey, Rob, Michelle, Kimberlee, Steven and Ryan along with 9 great grandchildren. He is also survived by his very special friend Ellen Watt, his brother-in-law Mike (Sally) Donally, and his mother-in-law, Dorothy Cascadden.
