



Mr. Glen Edward Eamor

October 6, 1928 - March 27, 2020

Mr. Glen Eamor formerly of Blackie, Alberta passed away on March 27, 2020 at AgeCare Walden Heights in Calgary at the age of 91 years.

Glen is survived by his daughters Avonelle (Jonathan) Crosby, Colleen (Dan) Gillespie, Susan Eamor; son Guy Eamor; grandchildren Rachel (Ed Dorey) Crosby, Erin (John) Christensen, Curtis Gillespie, Brant (Shustine) Eamor, Jordan Mazereeuw and Lauryn (Kyle) Hunter as well as 8 great-grandchildren. He is also survived by his sisters Arlayne Davies and Faye Thurber. Glen was predeceased by his wife Marion Eamor, his parents J.D. and Sue Eamor.

Glen was born in Vulcan, Alberta but spent the majority of his life in the community of Blackie. His career started at the early age of 6, with a profitable “Albertan” paper route in downtown Calgary.

By the age of 17 he had a School Bus Contract with the “Foothills School Division” in Blackie, which lasted for 35 years. He and his father later established a thriving International Harvester implement dealership in Blackie under “J.D. Eamor & Son” from 1945 – 1970. As if that wasn’t enough to keep our Dad busy, he engaged in his love of grain farming in the 60’s selling his last quarter section in 2018. “Yes, Dad you were a real slacker.”
