



Mr. Harvey Mitchell Podgurny

July 23, 1947 - July 25, 2025

Harvey Mitchell Podgurny, age 78, of High River, Alberta passed away on July 25, 2025, at the High River Hospital.

Harvey was born to Elsworth Lewis Johnston and Opal Walus Smith on July 23, 1947, at Peace River, Alberta. As young children, Harvey and his brothers Lewis and William were adopted by Blanche Lillian and William Frederick Podgurny. The Podgurny family farmed near Blue Ridge, Alberta. When the brothers were in their teens, the family moved to Edmonton, where they finished High School.

Harvey worked as a Legal Land Surveyor in his early 20's. He spent two years in the High Arctic, surveying for oil companies. Later he worked in Vancouver and Kamloops, B.C. before returning to Alberta. Harvey left surveying for construction and became a Journeyman carpenter. He worked on many projects at home and for friends. In 1980 he was hired by the City of Calgary, and in 1988 he became a civilian member of the Calgary Police Service. He loved the work and continued until his retirement in June, 2006.

Harvey loved to fish and camp, mostly in remote areas of Alberta and B.C. In younger years he bow hunted, played old timer hockey and softball. Later he discovered Pickleball, which he loved. Harvey and Lynda traveled to Italy and Greece in 2007, visited Hawaii once, and loved to wander around the

southwestern USA in truck and camper.

Harvey is survived by his wife, Lynda; daughter Natasha (Cody), grandsons Jaxom and Danny; son Harvest Johnston, (Finnessa) grandsons Seth and Levi, and their mother Lindsae Nichols, and Finnessa's children Charity, Grace, and Victor. Also survived by brothers Lewis and William Podgurny, sisters Hazel Ward, Marie (Dave) Dyck, Ethyl Velie, Irene Fortin, and Louise Dzaman (Darrell) and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by both his natural and adopted parents, sisters Dianne Johnston and Virgie Lawrence, and brother Harold Johnston.
