It is with great sadness that the family of Henny Scheffer of Nanton, AB, announce her passing on December 8, 2024, at the age of 89 years.

Henny was born in Nijverdal, Netherlands, to Hendrijke and Cornelius Scheffer. She was the second youngest of six children. Her family immigrated to Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada in the 1950's. Life was not easy for the family of eight, but Canada was a new beginning after the trials and tribulations they faced during wartimes in the Netherlands.

Henny and her family were recognized by the Yad Vashem as Righteous Among the Nations for their effort in World War II.

She enjoyed many careers over the years. Some of which included working as a banker, farmer, heavy equipment operator, handi-bus driver, and at a carpet factory. Henny was a crafter extraordinaire and put her whole heart into the pieces she made. She enjoyed many mediums such as crochet, stained glass, rug tufting, embroidery, and so much more.

Henny is survived by her family; sister-in-law Riet Scheffer; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and grand-nieces and grand-nephews both in the Netherlands and Canada. She was predeceased by her mother and father, Hendrijke and Cornelius Scheffer; and her siblings, Case (Toni), Herman, Ina,

Johanna (Klaas), and Tony (Olga).
