We are sad to announce the passing of Joan Beatrice Hornecker on April 7, 2020 at the age of 89 years. She was born October 27, 1930, the eldest of five children for Jessie and Dennis Mouser of Claresholm. She was raised on their farm north of Claresholm and was very involved in 4H growing up. After graduation she moved to Calgary, took a course in bookkeeping and worked there until her marriage.

Joan and Allen Hornecker were married July 3, 1954 and eventually settled on their farm west of Nanton where she resided for 50 years. Besides being busy raising their four children she was very involved in all aspects of farm life. Sewing had always been a very big part of her life and especially quilting. Her children, grandchildren and every niece and nephew can attest to that and all appreciate their quilts. She was very involved in the local chapter of Victoria Quilts as well Nanton's craft guild and was very proud of winning top prize for one of her quilts at the Calgary Stampede. She continued to quilt after she moved to Silver Willow Lodge and was finally happy to announce that in making the quilt for her bed at the lodge she finally managed to use up every last scrap of fabric which is a feat in itself if you know quilters.
