In the minor hockey world, Coach Justin was known as the coach with a red helmet and gloves whose goal was always to ensure that each player had fun. He was also a devoted dance dad who never missed a chance to watch his daughter do what she loved. He truly believed in community and the power of connecting with both kids and adults.

In his professional life, Justin was one of the most valued equity traders in the country. He earned the respect of both clients and his peers especially because of his unique, extraordinary ability to cultivate these business relationships into lasting friendships.

Whether it was skiing in Japan, sailing in the BVI's, scuba diving on the Great Barrier Reef, exploring wine caverns in France, or single-handedly planning a three week motor home trip with his family to the Gulf of Mexico and back. He was always looking for adventure. The dichotomy of Justin meant that he was equally as happy treating his wife to lavish experiences, like a dinner at the top of the Eiffel Tower, as he was drinking a beer and catching up with his buddies around a campfire.

Although he had many awesome accomplishments in life, his true passion was his family. As his kids will tell you, dad loved: ketchup chips, new black socks, everything red (including the Flames), crib, Jerry Rice, the Raiders, Dumb & Dumber, The Tragically Hip, and U2. But most of all, he loved family time - cuddles, games, weekend pancakes, and smoking ribs.

Justin really was SO MUCH and it is our hope that the focus moving forward will be on the countless moments of joy and laughter that he shared with his family and friends. He lived life fully and completely.
