Laurie Jeanne Bilozyr (nee: Anderson) passed away peacefully at AgeCare Skypointe on December 26, 2025 at the age of 74. Laurie is survived by her daughter Angela (Rob) Watson, her cherished grandchildren, James and Eric, her brother Stephen (Judy) Anderson, and several nieces, nephews, and cousins. She was predeceased by her beloved husband Don in 1989, and her parents Wilda, in 1990, and Hilton, in 2001.

A High River native, Laurie was born in 1951 and spent her childhood in groups including Brownies, CGIT, and Teen Town, and was the 1969 'teen queen'. She moved to Calgary in 1969 to attend university, and later worked at CIBC bank, where she met Don. They were married in February of 1978, and soon grew to a family of 3 with Angela's arrival in 1979. They had only a short time together due to Don's battle with MS but managed to build a lifetime of memories in only 11 years. After Don's passing, Laurie and Angela moved to Red Deer for a number of years before Laurie finally returned home to High River in 2001. She picked up her old sociable ways and joined Aquafit, Newcomer's Club, the church handbell choir, and played more than a few games of Mahjonn. She loved spending time with her grandchildren, and enjoyed every chance she got to travel with family and friends--especially cruises!
