Lawrence George Herriman passed away peacefully on November 16, 2012 at the High River Hospital at the age of 76 years. Lawrence and Marlene retired to High River where they enjoyed spending time travelling and their winters in New West Minster, summer holidays with friends and family, golfing with the seniors groups and Lawrence always enjoyed Wednesday morning coffee with the "Blackie Group" at the Legion and Thursday coffee with friends at McDonalds. Lawrence was on the board of Vista Mirage Association for four

years and retired in September due to his health.
