



Mr. Marion "Maj" Stanley Wojcik

July 13, 1943 - May 14, 2026

Beloved son, brother, husband, father, and grandfather passed away peacefully at home in the presence of family.

He is survived by his wife Luella of 58 years, daughters Andrea Wojcik, Regan Wojcik (Chris Browne), son Mike Wojcik (Jill Alexander), and grandsons Evan and Sam Browne and Brody Wojcik. As well as his sisters Rose Gurnsey (John Clancy), Regina Fayant (Leo), Cec Herman (Gary), and Dianna Wojcik (Alicia Cebrian) and numerous nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his father Stanley, mother Sophie, sisters Jean and Arlene, brother Michael, grandson Keagan Phillips, and brother-in-law Jim Cameron.

Maj was born on a farm in the Cudworth, Saskatchewan area. He attended a one room school with his older sisters for 2 years prior to moving to Wakaw with his family to attend school in town. He graduated from PACI in 1961. After attending University of Saskatchewan for 2 years, he entered the construction industry where he enjoyed the physical aspect of the job. During this time, Maj lost the vision in his right due to a freak accident. In Saskatoon in 1966, Maj met Luella Malcolm through mutual friends. They married in 1968. The same year, Maj returned to the U of S, then graduated in 1972 from the College of Commerce. Post graduation, Maj and Luella toured Europe for three and a

half months.

Upon their return to Canada, they “temporarily” moved to Calgary, Alberta. In Calgary, Maj joined the oil and gas industry as a production accountant. In this time, he assisted with the development of software for production accounting. They invested in residential real estate during the 70’s, 80’ s and 90’s. While in Calgary, daughters Andrea and Regan joined the family. In 1977, Maj and the three ladies moved to an acreage near High River where they were able to hobby farm. They kept Charolais cattle and a few horses while he commuted to work in downtown Calgary. They were soon joined by a son, Michael. Over the next 20 years, Maj and Luella chased the kids around to multiple sports, 4-H, school happenings in Blackie and High River, church activities, and various other random functions and events. In 1989, the family moved a few kilometers down the road to a house they had custom built. It was this house in which Maj peacefully passed away.

After the kids were well established in their careers, Maj and Luella began travelling. They started with friends to India and ended with friends to the Canadian High Arctic. Through their travels they toured all 7 continents.

Maj was an active member in the Knights of Columbus Joesph Cramer Council, where he was acting financial secretary for 2 terms and obtained his 3rd and 4th degrees. He was on the initial board of the Alderwood Community Association and was instrumental in reviving the association multiple years later. One of Maj’s most thankless, but most appreciated positions, was the bookkeeper/accountant for NAPA Okotoks (2011). He performed this role from 2011 until January of 2026 without pay.

Maj contributed and was respected as a member of the community, and many of the groups he worked with or for. His core values were caring, kindness, vigilance, and being supportive, especially with, and to his family.

Memorial Mass will be held at St. Francis de Sales Church in High River on Saturday, May 23, 2026 at 11:00 a.m.. The reception will follow in the church hall. Interment ceremonies will occur around 3:00 p.m. at the Highwood Cemetery Columbarium.
