Meryllyn Norma Dodds was a 4th generation High Riverite born July 5, 1939 to R.V. (Dinty) and Ina Moore.

After graduating HRHS she attended Mount Royal College in Calgary. Meryllyn married Derek Dodds in 1960 and together raised their children in the Calgary & Edmonton vicinities. They spent the last years of married life in Spruce Grove, AB. and after losing her husband in 1994 she moved to Calgary to be closer to family.

Meryllyn had many interests and talents which included, among other things, sewing, gardening, reading and a love of the great outdoors. Genealogy was of special interest to her and her insatiable quest for family history led her to countless days travelling in Eastern Canada & Europe searching microfiche, old church documents etc. Hundreds of hours were then spent on the writing and publication of 3 ancestral books tracing the family roots back to the 14th century.

Her personable nature led to the formation of innumerable lasting friendships, and her great strength & resiliency, vitality and sense of humour will be greatly missed by all who had the privilege of knowing her.
