



Mr. Patrick Joseph Farrelly

October 25, 1932 - August 23, 2022

Mr. Patrick Farrelly of High River passed away peacefully at his home on August 23, 2022, at the age of 89 years. Pat is survived by his wife of 58 years Jennifer, daughter Sara (Darcy), sons Richard and Robert (Coby) and his grandchildren Josée (Shawn), Riley, Keefe, Karsen, Payten, Quinn, and Adis.

Pat was born in Maynooth, Ireland to Florence and Edward and grew up in a family with six brothers and sisters. He left home at the age of 14 to live with his Aunty Molly in Liverpool, England. During his time in England he completed two years conscripted service in the British Army and an apprenticeship as a shipwright. Eventually he found his way into the merchant navy, applying his trade as a ship's carpenter. In his time there he travelled throughout the world and collected a trove of memories and stories he loved to share with family and friends.

Pat and Jennifer emigrated to Canada in 1968. Pat started putting his skills as a carpenter to work in Calgary, Alberta, and eventually started his own company in High River. He was well known for his craftsmanship in cabinetry, and there are many examples of it in the homes of High River.

He led a very active life and had many interests that kept his days busy even in retirement. Golf was always on the agenda and he hit the gym regularly

right up until his last days. As a supportive dad and grandfather he logged hours at the ice rinks, swimming pools, and ball diamonds. He was a lifelong football (soccer) fan, often watching games from overseas even if his favourite Everton was not involved.

Pat was always there for his family and friends and will be greatly missed. We were lucky to have him in our lives.

At Pat's request there will be no funeral service.
