May 4, 1919 - July 1, 2012

Pauline Winick passed away peacefully on Sunday July 1, 2012 at Cedars Villa Extendicare at the age of 93 years. She is survived by her sister Natalie Simpson, brother-in-law Glen Misner, numerous nieces, nephews and other extended family who will miss her.
