



Mr. Raymond Malcolm MacDonald

February 2, 1934 - August 2, 2012

Raymond passed away peacefully on Thursday, August 2nd at the High River Hospital at the age of 78 years. He is survived by his wife Dorothy, son David of Stony Plain and son Myles (Shelly) of Edmonton. Raymond is also survived by his grandchildren Luke and Samuel of High River, Nicole and Connor of Stony Plain and step-grandchildren Clint, Kyle and Tyler of Edmonton.

Surviving siblings are Florence, Catherine, Doris (Bob), Janet, Graham and Murray as well as numerous nieces and nephews. Raymond was predeceased by his daughter Dawn Mackie (2008); parents Rosanna and Malcolm "Scotty" MacDonald; sister Helen Charles of Los Angeles, California; and brother Larry MacDonald of Ft. Later in life Raymond kept busy oilfield consulting, golfing and teasing his grandchildren.
