



Mr. Reginald Graham Plumb

February 8, 1931 - December 26, 2022

It is with great sadness that the family of Reg Plumb announce his passing at the Vulcan Extendicare on December 26, 2022, at the age of 91 years. Reg is survived by his loving wife Gail, son Cody (Tami), and grandchildren Chase and Torynn.

He was predeceased by his parents Percy and Maude Plumb, brother Bertram, and sister Sybil.

Reg was born in Leamington Spa, Warwickshire, England. As a young man he worked at a farm in the Hereford area and for the railroad. At 16 he learned to drive truck taught by a tank driver from WWII. He also worked at a water company and plumbing company before going into the RAF from 1949-1951 stationed at Abington, England. He then drove double decker and tour buses for Midland Bus Co.

Reg moved to Canada on July 6, 1956 and went to work for International Harvester. In 1961-1962, he drove ambulance in the city of Calgary. He was employed with Greyhound Canada where he stayed from 1957-1996. In 1992 he was #1 man on the Greyhound Board and accomplished 34 years of safe driving.

In 1978 Reg, Gail, and Cody moved from Calgary to Nanton and built a new home where they resided and enjoyed many happy years.

Throughout the years, they enjoyed many trips together, England, Australia, Alaska, Hawaii, and others.

During his retirement he loved gardening and always had plenty of produce to give away. He enjoyed woodworking and having get togethers with friends and family, serving his Christmas pudding, sauce, shortbread, and homemade wine. He was an avid Calgary Stampeders fan and enjoyed watching football.

The two very special people in his life were his grandkids, Chase and Torynn. He loved spending time with them, watching them horse ride, work with 4H calves, and play sports. He was incredibly proud. He will be missed and remembered as a loving husband, father, grandfather, and friend.

The family would like to thank the staff and doctors at Vulcan Extendicare for the care they gave Reg over the last few years.
