



Mr. Richard Gerald Bondy

December 23, 1959 - October 4, 2025

It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Richard Gerald Bondy, who left us on October 4, 2025, at the age of 65.

Born on December 23, 1959, in High River, Alberta, Rick lived a life marked by hard work, independence, and a deep love of the open road. He built a long and dedicated career as a long-haul truck driver—a profession that perfectly suited his adventurous spirit. Rick found peace and freedom behind the wheel, with his loyal dog Tuffy often riding shotgun on countless road trips.

Those who knew Rick will remember his sharp wit and his remarkable ability to make others laugh when they needed it most. He had a unique way of lighting up a room—with a joke, a story, or simply by being there.

Later in life, Rick settled back in the Nanton area with his common-law wife, Avril. He took on a role with Rural Roads Construction as Keith's equipment hauler—work he truly enjoyed, especially because it meant being home most nights, something he wasn't used to after years on the road.

In 2002, Rick suffered a massive heart attack and stroke that changed the course of his life. Left paralyzed on his left side, he required care that went beyond what his loved ones could provide. He spent his remaining years in care facilities that, while necessary, were never quite suited to someone of his

age and spirit.

Rick is survived by his mother, Lillian Bondy of Nanton; his sister, Cindy (Doug) McDonald, also of Nanton; and his nieces, Stacy McDonald of Nanton and Camille McDonald of Airdrie. He was predeceased by his father, Joe Bondy, in 2020.

As per Rick's wishes, there will be no formal service.
