Richard Scherer, beloved husband, Papa, and Opa, passed away peacefully on March 28, 2023, at 80 years of age.

Richard was born in Teichdorf, Poland, on September 15, 1942, to the late Eduard and Berta Scherer. In 1955, the family was able to move from Germany and settle in Southern Alberta through sponsorship from the Lutheran Church. They worked on sugar beet farms to pay off their debt and to save enough money to buy some farmland near Coaldale.

Richard married Edelgard Widmer in 1973. They ran the Coaldale farm until they purchased land near Blackie, Alberta in 1975. The family moved to Blackie in 1979. Through the years, Richard, Edelgard and their four children, proudly built the family farm, through their hard work and dedication, growing it into the productive farm it is today.

He is survived by his wife of 49 years, Edelgard, and his children Andreas (Stephanie), Christine (Bryan), Thomas (Jennifer), and Paul (Jessie). He loved being an Opa to Lucas, Anna, and Katrina. He also leaves behind his sisters Erna, Lisa, Ingrid (Sjoert) and numerous relatives, nieces, nephews, and friends.

Richard was predeceased by his brother Erich, his sisters Wilma and Hilde,

and brothers-in-law Henry and Dieter.

Richard loved his family and farming was his life. Days were spent outside tending to animals, trees, and gardens. He enjoyed visiting and entertaining all while enjoying delicious home cooked meals. He was proud of his German heritage and passed on the language and traditions to his children and grandchildren. His kind smile, generous spirit and sense of humour will be greatly missed.

A Celebration of Richard's Life will be held on Friday April 14, 2023, at 11:30 am at the Highwood Memorial Centre. A lunch will follow the service.

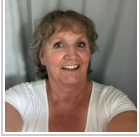
