On October 11, 2017, after courageously battling for 4 ½ years, Bob lost his struggle to cancer and passed peacefully away with Kendra and family at his side. Fellow employees from both Telus and The Home Depot, will also remember Bob's meticulous attention to detail and his quirky sense of humor.

Bob moved west from Windsor, Ontario in his early twenties where he began his career with the then AGT (now Telus). More than thirty years with Telus allowed him to transition to become a valued employee of the electrical department of The Home Depot after retirement from Telus.
