It's with great sadness that we announce the passing of Everett Fisher. Everett was a beloved husband, father, grandpa, brother and friend. He spent most of his adult life in the High River area raising his family while working the family farm. He had a passion for farming and was fortunate to chase that passion for most of his 89 years. He was once quoted as saying "I'll likely never make much money at this but I can't think of anything else I'd rather do".

He was born at Welwyn, Saskatchewan as the second of six children born to Edwin and Jean Fisher. He grew up on the family farm and at age 24 he moved to High River and worked on several different farms. Everett married his wife Carol in 1962 and together they made farming their career while raising three sons. Their family grew with the addition of daughters-in-law and many grandchildren who loved to visit the farm.

Everett is survived by his wife Carol; sons Dean (Gwen), Greg (Tracy) and Brad (Janice); his grandchildren Ryan, Russell, Taylor, Mackenzie, Kennedy, Mason, Megan and Lucas; as well as his great-grandchildren Kyden and Calysta. Everett is also survived by his brother Wes (Cheryl); sister-in-law Jo Fisher and brother-in-law Bob Ballard. He was predeceased by his parents Edwin and Jean; sister Frances; brothers Fred, John and Garfield as well as his brother-in-law Howard Kirkpatrick and sister-in-law Karen Fisher.
