August 4, 1934 - June 1, 2021

Reverend Robert Griffiths of High River, Alberta passed away at the High River Hospital on June 1, 2021 at the age of 86 years. Robert is survived by his loving wife Judy; step-sons Jeffrey Woodgate and Phillip Woodgate.

Robert was born in Calgary, Alberta where he completed his high school and then attended University of British Columbia at the Vancouver School of Theology. He served many parishes throughout Alberta and B.C. as well as short stays in Toronto and Saskatchewan. Robert finished his Priesthood at St. Benedict's Anglican Church in High River where he and Judy retired.

A Memorial Service will be held at a later date.

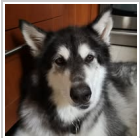
