Mrs. Sandra Reynolds of High River, Alberta passed away at the High River Hospital on August 2, 2020 at the age of 72 years.

Sandy was born in Killam Alberta on December 25th, 1947 to Albert and Sheila Child and died peacefully at the High River General Hospital on August 2nd, 2020 at the age of 72.

She is survived by her loving husband Ross, sister Barb (Don), brother Rick, her son Dave and his stepchildren Franky and Aliesha, her daughter Tammy (Donald) and their children Kayla, Samantha, and Bailey, and numerous nieces and nephews.

Sandy was predeceased by her parents Albert and Sheila and sister-in-law Sharon.
