



Mrs. Sharon Lynn Wegener

April 7, 1958 - July 13, 2025

It is with great sadness that the family of Sharon Lynn Wegener of High River, AB, announce her passing on Sunday July 13, 2025 at the age of 67 years, surrounded by family.

Sharon Wegener was born in Castor, Alberta to Cyril and Irene (nee Robinson) Yates. Her early years were spent moving throughout southern Alberta as her father trained to become a grain elevator agent and manager. She attended school in Alix, Blackie, Cayley, and High River before settling in Barons, where she attended LCI in Lethbridge for Grade 11.

Sharon was one of seven siblings—Allan, Barbara, Linda, Joyce, Jackie, and Byron. As a child, she was active in Light Horse 4-H with her older sisters and enjoyed playing basketball, baseball, and other sports. After losing her mother at an early age, she took on a caring role in the family, often helping to look after her younger siblings. Whether lending a hand with daily routines or offering emotional support, Sharon's nurturing spirit shone through.

In 1975, Sharon moved to High River to be with her teenage sweetheart, William ("Bill") Wegener. She worked as a server at the Pioneer Restaurant and then Robinson's store. She began her career at the Royal Bank as a Customer Service Representative on October 31, 1977. Her dedication and professionalism led her through several leadership and support roles,

culminating in her retirement after 46 years in April 2023.

Sharon and Bill were married on May 6, 1978. Together, they shared a love of sports—especially fastball—and traveled throughout Alberta and British Columbia to watch Bill play in tournaments. They welcomed their first daughter, Kristie, on May 27, 1983, followed by their second daughter, Shantel, on March 8, 1988.

Known for her vibrant personality, Sharon was funny, adventurous, energetic, and deeply devoted to those around her. The holidays and birthdays were especially important to her family get togethers were mandatory to celebrate those. She cherished time with family and friends—whether it was camping at Dickey Lake (Montana), summer vacations in Sandpoint (Idaho), and quick getaways to McGregor Lake, Travers Reservoir or Little Bow (Alberta). She had a love of “oldies” music from the 60s, 70s and 80s. It was not long after her favorite song would blare through the speakers before she was up twisting and dancing to the tunes. In addition to her love of music, Sharon also loved cozy evenings playing board games, card games, crib and reading novels. She was a devoted Calgary Flames (NHL) fan and Toronto Blue Jays (MLB) fan and enjoyed watching chuckwagon races in person and on the television. She had a special bond with animals and pets and offered them the same kindness and affection she gave her loved ones.

One of Sharon’s greatest joys was being a grandmother. She absolutely adored her two grandchildren, Trace and Tate, and treasured every moment spent with them—whether baking cookies and making Jello salad, spoiling them with holiday and birthday gifts, or simply sharing laughter and small adventures. They were her pride and joy, and she lit up in their presence.

Sharon was predeceased by her father, Cyril Yates; her mother, Irene Robinson; her stepmother, Eileen Suitor; her older siblings, Allan, Barbara,

and Linda; and her brother-in-law, Murray Malowski.

She is survived by her husband, Bill; her daughters, Kristie Wegener (Bruce Christianson) and Shantel (Tyler) Moore; and her beloved grandchildren, Trace and Tate Moore; sisters, Joyce (Dennis Pugh) and Jackie; and brother, Byron as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

Sharon lived with warmth and enthusiasm, leaving behind a legacy of laughter, loyalty, and love.

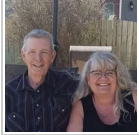
