



## Mr. Thomas "Ed" Edward Tribe

August 18, 1936 - April 12, 2018

Ed Tribe of Nanton, AB passed away peacefully with his family by his side at the age of 81 at the High River Hospital on April 12, 2018.

Ed is survived by his loving wife, Eleanore; son, Bill (Natasha); grandson Max; Brothers Moe (Ev), Doug (Lorraine), and several nieces and nephews from BC to Ont and Overseas. He was predeceased by his parents, William and Jean Tribe; Sisters Jeannie Morphet and Gordona Cayer and their spouses.

Ed was born in Emo, Ontario where he spent his first 18 years. He joined the Canadian Forces in 1958. He spent the next 28 years in the Provost Corp (Military Police) and served on several Canadian Forces Bases throughout his career namely, Canadian High Commission, Cyprus; Canadian Airborne Regiment; Rivers, MB; Soest, Germany; Edmonton; Calgary; Penhold; and Baden-Soellingen, Germany.

After retiring from the Military in 1988, he and family settled in Calgary and subsequently moved to Nanton in 2002 where he spent many happy years and built many great friendships through The Legion; The Golf Club; The Senior's Curling Club; and the Kosy Korner Senior's Centre.

At Ed's request there will not be a funeral. However, recognizing Ed's deep involvement in the community and the Legion, there was a Legion Service at

2:30 p.m. on Saturday, April 28, 2018 at the Nanton Community Centre, (21st Ave & 18 St, Nanton, AB) followed by a time of refreshments and reminiscing as we continue to celebrate Ed's life.
