Mr. Gerry Mitchell of Cardston, Alberta (formerly of High River, Alberta) passed away peacefully surrounded by his family at the Good Samaritan Lee Crest Nursing Home in Cardston.

Gerry is survived by his children Leslie Mitchell-Leavitt, Brian Mitchell and Doug Mitchell; grandchildren Levi Mason, Baxter Mason, Abigail Mason, Isaac Leavitt and Elizabeth Leavitt. Gerry was predeceased by his parents Norman and Ada Mitchell.

Gerry was born in Chilliwack, BC and later moved to Calgary, AB. He worked after High School and eventually attended the University of Calgary for his Bachelor of Arts. He began working for the City of Calgary transit department in urban planning in 1974 and in 1975 built a house and moved down to High River with his family. Commuting with friends he continued to work for the city for 27 years until he retired in 2001. Gerry also operated a wine making supply business in High River and loved serving his clients in the area. He was a very proud member of the community and always stayed active in the Kinsmen Club, Chamber of Commerce, Curling Club, Citizens on Patrol, to name a few. He was an avid jogger who ran in dozens of road races over the years and later enjoyed playing pool, golfing and riding his motorbike with friends. More than anything, Gerry enjoyed spending time with his kids and grandkids and sharing laughs with all those he cared about.
