Mr. Wayne Schlosser of Stavely, Alberta passed away at the High River Hospital on March 5, 2026 at the age of 90 years.

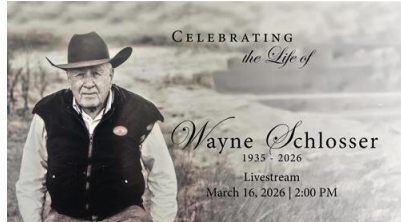
